Respondent, Claudia C. Wisnousky, appeals contending the property division made by the trial court in her dissolution action was inequitable. Petitioner, Jerome L. Wisnousky, contends on cross-appeal that he should have been awarded a larger lump sum property settlement, but contends in all other respects that the decision of the trial court should be affirmed.

On our de novo review we determine that the trial court has made an equitable division of the property of the parties.
