**PER CURIAM**

Appellant Mary Christine Edwards appeals her adjudication as a delinquent, having committed an assault on her mother and sister contrary to section 708.1, Supplement to The Code 1977, and her placement in the Iowa Training School for Girls at Mitchellville. The sole issue to be resolved is whether the evidence sustains the trial court's finding beyond a reasonable doubt with respect to the alleged act of delinquency. Section 232.31, The Code. Upon reviewing the evidence, we conclude that it does and affirm the trial court.
